

Gender, Peace and Security Certificate Award

We welcome submissions for the 2023 Gender, Peace and Security Certificate. This award aims to encourage and recognize outstanding work by Gender, Peace and Security certificate students. We encourage certificate students to submit research papers that explore the gendered dimensions of international relations, conflict, and peacebuilding. Students must have earned the certificate or must be enrolled in the Gender, Peace and Security graduate certificate program to apply.

The award committee considers quality of the work, originality, application of a gender lens or intersectional analysis, clarity of writing and presentation, and relevance to research, policy, and/or practice. The author of the winning paper will be awarded \$2500.

Eligibility criteria:

- Applicant must **either** be currently enrolled in the Gender, Peace and Security certificate **or** have graduated with the Gender, Peace and Security certificate in the 2022-2023 academic year.
- Submissions may not exceed 5,000 words (footnotes, endnotes, and bibliography count towards the word limit).
- Submissions must be single-authored. Group papers will not be accepted.

To apply for the award, please submit your research paper, including a cover sheet that lists your name, GUID, and email address, in a single PDF file to Dr. Robert Nagel at rn538@georgetown.edu.

Submission deadline is Friday, June 2, 2023.

Please note that the committee will only consider submissions that meet all eligibility criteria.
